ARE YOU ELIGIBLE? Open to Colorado licensed pharmacists and pharmacy interns, the program emphasizes early intervention. When a referral is made—by a friend, family member, peer, supervisor or yourself—an extensive assessment begins. Once it is determined that the public's safety is not endangered, an individualized treatment and rehabilitation program is structured.

The combination of early intervention, stringent monitoring and strong support is powerful. It protects the public. It yields significant cost-savings to employers. And, if you are the pharmacist at risk, it can even save your life.

PHARMACIST PEER HEALTH ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

- Available to Colorado licensed pharmacists and pharmacy interns
- Confidential alternative to the traditional disciplinary process
- Provides early intervention
- Aids in maintaining or re-entering professional practice
